Outcomes

- By the end of the:
- 60 drop outs/ESLs will have gained multiple benefits from their participation and regained confidence in their employability putting them on a more equal footing with their formally qualified peers.
 - Produced a youth-led educational, training and skills development programme on socio-economic inclusion of drop outs/ESLs. Delivered directly to 200 beneficiaries.
 - Trained, mentored and supported ambassadors to develop and promote the course through a series of targeted engagement campaigns.
 - Set up a coaching and support hub to serve as a centre for further guidance and support for beneficiaries enrolled on the e-course.
 - Hold a CPD and Youth Pass accredited conference where young people and stakeholders will be brought together.
 - Delivered online awareness activities to over 13,000 relevant stakeholders

Indicators

- Reported increased paid employment and job opportunities for European ESLs/drop out beneficiaries
- Increased uptake of e-courses and completed accredited training
- Increase in the number of youth passes awarded to young people and increased employability will be reported
- Use of Coaching and Support Hub for continued networking between stakeholders and young people
- E-book readers reporting that they feel more knowledgeable about the subject
