Project Update

The innovative [online platform](#), developed by InEuropa srl in cooperation with partners, is in the final stage of piloting in all partner countries with young dropouts. The feedback from the piloting will help partners to finalise the online self-capacitating and networking platform, which will be available even after the end of the project.

The modules on the Drop-In course are the following: Personal Development, Critical Thinking, Career Planning, Basic Project Management, Basic Finance, Digital Literacy and Enterprise,

Social Skills and Civic Responsibilities.

The content is composed of guidelines, case studies, videos and quizzes.

The main purpose of this online platform, which is available in all partners' languages, is to bridge the gap between the labour market and disadvantaged youth, by tackling their skills mismatches.

The Conference

[KMOP-Social Action and Innovation Centre](#) organised on the 8th of February, an International Conference in Athens with more than 80 participants. The aim of this Conference was to identify the most important skills in the modern workplace and to present the online platform with a view to transfer the learning experience to more users at national level. The main conclusion of this Conference was that **adaptability**, **resilience** and **critical thinking** are the necessary skills for (re)integration of disadvantaged youth to the labour market.

The Third Transnational Partners' Meeting in Athens

KMOP-Social Action and Innovation Centre, organised and hosted in its headquarters the 3rd Transnational Partners Meeting on the 7th of February. During the meeting partners discussed all the relevant topics regarding the project implementation such as the pilot testing of the online platform, the development of the final e-book and other major issues of the project management, dissemination and evaluation.

Next Steps

After the piloting of the online platform in all partners' countries, the project partners will develop the final version of the online platform, available in 4 languages. Then, the development of the e-book will present all the activities, results and deliverables of the project in a European and national context in each partner country. Finally, the International Closing Drop-In Conference and the final Transnational Partners' Meeting will take place in London UK, during July of 2019 and they will be organised by [The IARS International Institute](#).

The Project is funded by the European Commission and runs for 24 months (September 2017 – August 2019).
